- TO EXTEND THE VALIDITY OF A LIMITED PASSPORT. Submit appropriate evidence to support your request.

- THERE IS NO FEE FOR THIS SERVICE. Your amended passport and any documentary evidence submitted will be returned to you by first-class mail. IF you desire (SPECIAL POSTAL SERVICE (registered, special delivery), include appropriate postage fees.

NOTE: A passport agency may NOT mail a passport to a private address outside the United States.

**AUTHORITIES:** The information solicited on this form is requested pursuant to provisions in Titles 8, 18, and 22, United States Code, whether or not codified, including specifically 22 U.S.C. 211a, 212, and 213, and all regulations issued pursuant to Executive Order 11295 (August 5, 1966), including 22 CFR Part 51, including but not limited to 22 C.F.R. 51.24 (change of name); 51.4 (validity of passport); and 22 C.F.R. 51.32 (amendment of passport).

**PURPOSE:** The primary purpose for soliciting the information is to establish entitlement to the passport amendment or validation request. The information may also be used in connection with issuing other travel documents or evidence of citizenship, and in furtherance of the Secretary's responsibility for the protection of U.S. nationals abroad.

**ROUTINE USES:** The information is made available as a routine use on a need-to-know basis to personnel of the Department of State. The principle users of this information are offices within the Bureau of Consular Affairs. Information may also be provided to other government agencies having statutory or other lawful authority to gain access to such information in the performance of their official duties; pursuant to a court order; and as set forth in Part 171, Title 22 C.F.R.

The submission of this form is mandatory in order to obtain the passport amendment or validation requested. Individuals who fail to submit this form or who do not provide all the requested information may be denied the service request.

**ACTS OR CONDITIONS**
